1. UNIVERSITY COLLEGES OF MERIT IPE

L'IPE (Institute for education and research) is a non-profit organisation that promotes various educational and cultural activities for young people. Its goal is to expose them to culture, education and the world of work. I.P.E. runs three "Collegi Universitari di Merito (Villalta, Monterone and Poggiolevante)" which are accredited by the Ministry of Education, University and Research:

4. FEES AND SCHOLARSHIPS IPE

The annual fee, in the absence of scholarship recognition, for individual Colleges is the one expected for the highest ISEE band.

Scholarships based on income

So as to promote access to the colleges for deserving young people and to remove economic obstacles, IPE provides scholarships and grants based on family income. The allocation of these scholarships and grants does not involve direct payments to the student, but a reduction in annual fees. For the academic year 2018-2019 fees are set as specified below according to the relevant ISEE certificate (type: "Benefits for the right to university study").

In the event of students residing in the college for periods less than one academic year, fees are calculated based on the number of months stayed (e.g. Erasmus students).

The conditions for applying for a scholarship grant are as follows:

- ✓ be admitted to one of the IPE Boards and enrolled at the University of Bari or Naples, for degree courses, specializations, masters and research doctorates; be enrolled in the Institutions of Higher Artistic, Musical and Choral Training of Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry;
- ✓ have obtained at least 75% of the ECTS provided by the degree programme for the previous academic year as of October 31, 2018;
- \checkmark have achieved a weighted average of at least 26/30 as of 31 October 2018.

Scholarships and grants

With the purpose of promoting access to the colleges to young gifted students without the economic burden of full fees, I.P.E. offers a number of scholarships and grants. The issuing of these scholarships and grants, which can be combined with that of income, do not consist of direct payments but a reduction of the annual fee from a minimum of \pounds 1,000 to a maximum of \pounds 2,000 per year according to the following table:

In the event that the student does not meet the requirements for selection, the deduction will be applied to the entire amount (see tables of the individual Boards).

The requirements for scholarships and grants are:

- ✓ be admitted to one of the IPE Boards and enrolled at the University of Bari or Naples, for degree courses, specialisation, masters and research doctorates; be enrolled in the Institutions of Higher Artistic, Musical and Choral Training of Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry;
- ✓ By October 31, 2018, universitystudents from second year on must have achieved at least 75% of the ECTS of their degree program for the academic year-2017-2018. The exam average must be weighed and, in any case, it refers to the evaluation system of the university of enrolment. For graduates, it is necessary to have completed the graduation programme within the specified period time and to have graduated no more than two years from October 31, 2018.me

Special Scholarships

In order to encourage foreign student participation in the IPE colleges, Master's, ASIRID Project, students and graduates with particular conditions defined by specific agreements between IPE and different Universities, scholarships will be awarded up to a maximum of €5,000 per year according to the following table. The special scholarship cannot be combined with scholarships for income and merit.

The requirements for scholarships and grants are:

- ✓ Be admitted to one of the IPE boards;
- ✓ Meet one of the following conditions:
 - 1. <u>Foreign students</u>, be enrolled at the University of Bari or Naples, for degree courses, specialisation, masters and research doctorates or be enrolled in the Institutions of Higher Artistic, Musical and Choral Training of Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry;
 - 2. IPE Master's student, be admitted to the IPE School,
 - 3. <u>Special conventions</u>, meet the conditions set by the agreement

The award of scholarship will be communicated by e-mail to the winning candidates within **7 days from** having received the application.

Students chosen for a scholarship will have the amount paid directly to the College by IPE so as to reduce the fee amount. The scholarship will be paid for the months of effective stay in the College. Scholarships for income and merit are cumulative. On the basis of the scholarship award date, the winners will be called for a cognitive interview and presentation of their EDUCATIONAL PROJECT at the IPE headquarters (Riviera di Chiaia 264, Naples).

Scholarship holders undertake to collaborate and promote the academic and cultural activities promoted by IPE both at the different Colleges and at the university centres of choice.

The granting of the aforementioned scholarships will take place until the total amount assigned for scholarships and grants by IPE is exhausted.

Other concessions

For new students admitted to the Colleges that have siblings who are already resident in the colleges, it is possible to take advantage of a 15% discount on the monthly fee.

5. GRANTS, BURSARIES and CONVENTIONS WITH INPS

In convention with INPS, scholarships are available for students whose parents work for the civil service and for students who are orphans of former civil service employees, respecting the parameters stipulated for the academic year 2018-2019 in the document "Collegi Universitari" which is available on the INPS website. The INPS scholarship can cover up to 100% of the annual fee. The beneficiaries of the above mentioned scholarships will be nominated directly by INPS and cannot be contested. Nonetheless, they must pass IPE admission procedure.

6. REQUEST FOR ADMISSION AND REQUEST FOR APPLICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

7. ADMISSION TEST

The test includes a review of qualifications, aptitude tests and admission interviews with the management of the individual colleges. For Collegio di Villalta, prospective students are required to stay in residence of one day (meals must be paid for by the individual). For students wishing to benefit from an INPS scholarship, the interview must take place before August 2018.

Admissions are up to the discretion of the Directorate of the College up until all available places have been exhausted. Offers of acceptance will be issued by e-mail within 7 days from the date of the selection process.

8. CONTRACT OF RESIDENCE

The relationship between the student and the College is governed by an annual contract of residence that stipulates the economic conditions and conditions of residence to which we undersign for the academic year2018-2019.

The signing of the aforementioned contract allows the parents of students residing outside of their place of residence to benefit from tax deductions.

9. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Annual fees must be paid in four tranches as for the following scheme:

- 20% of fees by September 10th, 2018 (by July 10th for those reconfirming);
- 20% of fees by November 10th, 2018;
- 30% of fees by January 10th, 2019;
- 30% of fees by April 10th, 2019;

Students enrolled in first year are required to pay €1000.00 in advance within seven days of admission. This amount will be deducted from the amount of the first instalment.

10.ANNUAL RECONFIRMATION

The admission is for the academic year 2018/2019 only. In order to confirm, students must maintain the following standards and application must be completed using the form found on the following www.ipeistituto.it/collegi2018-19:

- obtain 75% of the credits necessary to complete their course of study (University and AFAM) for the academic year 2017-2018 and achieve an average grade of 26/30 (for university students and students attending specialisation courses);
- successfully complete the previous academic year for PhD students;
- pass an evaluation by the college Directors with regards to the participation in College life;
- having respected the objectives established in the Personal Formative Project signed at the beginning of the year.

In cases where, for justified and substantiated reasons, the above requirements are not respected, Directors are empowered to assess the individual situation.

The confirmation will be issued by the Directors by July 10th 2019.
