VILLALTA

Naples, which is home to five universities, offers a great range of possibilities for young people intending to enrol at university.

The Villalta College for Girls is the perfect place for female students of all Faculties in Naples to advance their culture and their human formation: both for students from outside Naples and for those from this city who are looking for somewhere to study, to make friends and to invest time and energy in their future.

The College was inaugurated in November 2001 and it is in Chiaia district, a convenient area within reach of the universities of Naples and the centre for cultural events, entertainment and shopping. The residence offers to the students different types of cultural activities and counselling services for university and work.

It offers a complete formation that promotes the development of mature personalities, capable of converting limits to resources and obstacles to opportunities.

STUDY ENVIRONMENT

The University Residence promotes specific initiatives involving different courses of study and addressed to students. The aim of the activities is to promote integration between university education and situations in the workplace. For this reason, university professors and experts participate in these activities.

COMPETENCE ASSESSMENT AND METHODOLOGY

The competence assessment is a service offered to all the students staying at or frequenting the Villalta College. Every student is assigned to a mentor (one of the directors) who will help him/her during periodic meetings in order to aid maturity.

Meetings to discuss study methods (both individual and collective) are offered throughout the year, addressed particularly to students attending the first years at university.

COURSES

Courses held both at Villalta College and at the headquarters of the IPE institution are provided during the year.

ACTIVITIES

Villalta College organises for those living in student accommodation:

FAMILY ENVIRONMENT

The “Tertulia” is a fundamental moment of life in Villalta: it is an informal meeting that occurs after dinner, when students have the possibility to share their daily adventures with the others, read the newspapers or discuss outstanding world events, cultivating reciprocal interest. These brief moments are essential to develop mutual attention, listening, respect for others and favours the birth of new friendships.

STRUCTURE AND SERVICES

The Residence was once an ancient stately home, Villa Nobili, converted to a university residence in 2001.

Now the mansion is composed of five floors, the first three house the common spaces such as hall, study halls, dining room, library, meeting room, living room, chapel etc.

The other two floors house the bedrooms. The structure is also provided with a garden and a panoramic terrace.

The Residence offers a series of services in order to guarantee a comfortable environment. The services included are:

- study halls and library
- air-conditioning and wired internet connection
- single/triple rooms
- meals included (breakfast, lunch, dinner)
- change of bath towels and bed linen
- laundry service for clothes and underwear
- cleaning of rooms

ADMISSION

SELECTION

The selection process leading to admission to Villalta College consists of two phases:

- Sending to segreteria.villalta@gmail.com an application (including a cover letter of at least 2000 characters, curriculum vitae with passport photo and academic results – for first year students school reports and a certificate attesting to the final results of the school leaving diploma) using the appropriate pdf file.

- *a trial period of 24 hours including one night (a 50 euro reimbursement of expenses is required) during which time participants can experience life in Villalta first-hand, together with the regulations and the activities on offer.*

The results will be announced by e-mail a few days after the selection process. On arrival at Villalta College to stay stably, the student will sign a contract that stipulates the fees and instructions for payment, the rules of living together and the training plan. Observance of these obligations is essential.

Instead of a day as trial period, foreign students begin living in Villalta, but after a trial period of 1 month the direction could admit or not admit the candidate to remain stably in the Residence.

Foreign students must make an effort to **learn the Italian language** as soon as possible in order to be able to settle down to college life and this condition is indispensable to continue to stay at the Residence.

FEES

The payment of fees for board and lodging includes the right to accommodation in a single or triple room, meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), laundry service, participation in the cultural activities offered by the College and the use of equipment and indoor and outdoor facilities.

The fee depends on the type of room chosen: the maximum charge for a single room amounts to 950,00 euros, while for the triple it is 750,00 euros.

The fees are to be paid in ten monthly instalments, with a deposit of a month's payment in advance.

The IPE -the institution running the College- offers annual scholarships based on merit and income, see the Regulation on the IPE website for more details.

GRANTS

The IPE institution offers two scholarships that may be combined in order to simplify the admittance:

- a grant calculated on income to limit the expenses of families according to the ISEE
- a grant for merit to reward commitment and results achieved by brilliant students.

The IPE institution also offers grants of a maximum of 4000 euros a year (divided into ten monthly payments) in order to promote the presence of foreign students.

The application form and the required documents should be sent to the IPE in order to obtain the grant.

The IPE institution has also recently made some special provisions to allow students with special needs to stay in their accommodation at reduced rates.

The INPDAP Agreement is addressed to students whose parents work in the Italian public administration.

The Convention for the Faculty of Engineering, Federico II is addressed to the first 300 students at the entry test to the Faculty of Engineering, Federico II University.

HOW TO REACH US



FROM CAPODICHINO AIRPORT:

- Take Alibus (every 22 minutes) as far as Piazza Garibaldi (central train station in Naples) and then underground number two line to Pozzuoli as far as Piazza Amedeo, then 10 minutes walk.



FROM CENTRAL TRAIN STATION

- Take underground line 2 in the direction of Pozzuoli as far as Piazza Amedeo, then 10 minutes walk.



FROM MOTORWAYS

- Motorway exit Napoli Via Marina, go straight on through Piazza Municipio, Piazza Vittoria, Riviera di Chiaia, Via S. Pasquale, Piazza S. Pasquale, Via G. Carducci, Via dei Mille, Piazza Amedeo, Via G. Martucci 35H.
- Bypass exit Vomero Via Cilea, go straight on through Via Tasso, C.so Vittorio Emanuele, Via del Parco Margherita, P.zza Amedeo, Via G. Martucci 35H.
